REQUEST FOR HOUSEHOLD TOILET FACILITIES

Please accept my felicitation.

On behalf of the chiefs and people of Ninting, I respectfully and humbly apply to your organization, Turbo Ghana, to extend your assistance in the construction and provision of household and schools toilet facilities to the community to help address the critical challenge of poor environmental sanitation.

The only public KVIP built by the Interbeton, the foreign company that constructed the Kumasi-Ejura-Atebubu highway in the late 1980s as part of its corporate social responsibility to the community has outlived its durability and also creating a health and environmental hazard to the local R/C Primary school, on whose premises it was built. The one built by the Mampong Municipal Assembly about 15 years ago is also not serving the sanitation needs of the people due to the acute scarcity of water supply. As a result, the people resort to open defecation at backyards and nearby bushes as their only option.

As a community of about three thousand (3,000) inhabitants whose main sources of drinking water are streams, that, incidentally are located in low lying areas, the health and environmental implications are obvious. Thus, rampant cases of typhoid, air and water borne diseases are matters of serious concern, not only to the people, but also the Municipal Health and Education directorates.

Having observed from testimonies with evidence by succeeding MCEs and Assembly Members during General Meetings of the Mampong Municipal Assembly about your commendable support to some towns in the Municipality, I look up to you for support to provide households at Ninting with decent places of convenience for personal and environmental hygiene as well as for good health.

About Ninting

Ninting is the community located immediately before the famous Mampong Scarp from the Mampong direction toward Kumasi. It has a population of about 3, 000 residents. The people are mainly subsistent farmers whose main source of income is the sale of excess of their farm produce to commuters along the main road.
